The FDA has a dedicated staff member to focus resources on third-party payers in Florida and their impact on members. Working closely with the various insurance plans, Medicaid managed-care plans, the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA), Department of Health, Board of Dentistry (BOD) and other state and federal agencies, the FDA Director of Third Party Payer and Professional Affairs addresses issues relating to third-party payers. PEER REVIEW

You often can avoid costly legal fees and malpractice suits by using this free service available only to members. Peer Review doesn't always have to be started by a disgruntled patient. A frustrated dentist who feels that everything has been done to satisfy the patient, with no success, also can recommend Peer Review. This is a service provided by colleagues to other members to help mediate problems, and most of the time avoid costly and emotionally draining litigation or Board of Dentistry complaints.

FDAPAC AND ADPAC

Dentistry's state and federal political action committees ensure the association has a place at the table when lawmakers are debating legislation that affects dentistry. The FDA Political Action Committee (FDAPAC) Board of Directors and American Dental Political Action Committee (ADPAC) work hard to identify and support dental-friendly candidates. The FDA works with state agencies and the ADA to promote fluoridation. Florida Board of Dentistry Update

The Florida Board of Dentistry (BOD) met in Gainesville on Friday, February 18th, at 7:30 a.m. The Florida Dental Association (FDA) was represented by FDA BOD Liaison, Dr. Joe Calderone and Director of Third Party Payer and Professional Affairs, Casey Stoutamire. Drs. Andy Brown, Jim Haddix and Suzi Thiems-Heflin also were in attendance. In addition, many University of Florida dental students and Santa Fe Community College hygiene and assisting students attended the meeting. The BOD approved the following language:

64B5-14.004 Continuing Education Requirement.

(1) Each biennium, all dentists who hold an active sedation permit of any level must complete a four (4) hour board-approved continuing education course in Medical Emergencies, four (4) hours of continuing education in airway management and four (4) hours of continuing education in medical-emergencies, every four (4) years from the last date the dentist took the continuing education course. The four (4) hours in airway management must include two hours didactic training in providing dentistry on sedated patients with compromised airways and two hours must include hands-on training in airway management of sedated patients. The continuing education must be taken through a board approved continuing education provider. The continuing education required by this subsection will take effect on March 1, 2014. The continuing education required by this subsection may be included in the thirty (30) hours required by Section 466.0135, F.S.

(2) To be approved by the board, the Medical Emergencies continuing education course must include a hands-on airway management component. During the licensure biennial renewal period that begins on March 1, 2020, and every licensure biennial renewal period thereafter, all dentists who hold an active sedation permit of any level shall take the following continuing education instead of the continuing education required in subsection (1): A four (4) hour board approved continuing education course in Medical Emergencies that shall include airway management as a component of the course: (3) The Medical Emergencies continuing education course must be taken through a board approved continuing education provider.

Prosthodontic “Pearls” for Enhanced Efficiency in Implant Dentistry, Dr. Jay Smith
