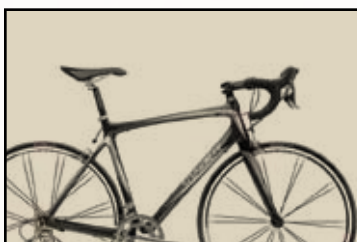

Current Concepts In Oral Medicine:

Diagnostic Pearls - 3 CE credits

The World Health Organization has predicted that in the 21st century, dentists will assume the role of “Oral Physicians”. This course will cover medical history, physical diagnosis, current American Heart Association and American Association of Orthopaedic Surgeons premedication regimens, Bisphosphonate-Associated Osteonecrosis, physical diagnosis and pattern recognition and radiographic changes of the periodontal ligament space.

This course will examine commonly encountered oral soft tissue pathology to include candidiasis, allergies, aphthous ulcerations and lichen planus.

Michael A. Siegel, DDS, MS, FDS RCSEd is Professor and Chair of Oral Medicine and Diagnostic Sciences, College of Dental Medicine and Professor of Internal Medicine and Dermatology, College of Osteopathic Medicine at Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Dr. Siegel is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons (Edinburgh), a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Medicine, a Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry, a Fellow of the International College of Dentists, and a Fellow of the American College of Dentists. He holds a Masters degree in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. He was recently included in the *International Who's Who in Medicine*. Dr. Siegel has lectured internationally and has published extensively in the field of Oral Medicine to include a textbook on diagnosis and management of common oral lesions. Dr. Siegel is a section editor of the *Journal of the American Dental Association*, serves on the editorial boards of *Oral Surgery Oral Medicine Oral Pathology* the *Journal of Interdisciplinary Dentistry* and *Inside Dentistry*. He is also a journal reviewer for 15 international and national professional publications. He is a past President of the American Academy of Oral Medicine, a past President of the American Board of Oral Medicine and a past Chairman of the American Dental Association's Council on Scientific Affairs. He is currently the Chair of the Council of Faculties at the American Dental Education Association. He is a native of Baltimore, Maryland. He has a part-time specialty practice limited to Oral Medicine in the Fort Lauderdale area.

Learn how to communicate how esthetics, occlusion, and function are so intimately related. Explore how to quickly create a more stable occlusion and beautiful smile and maintain it long-term. Learn how to convince your patients the need for appropriate treatment and to pay for such services with sincere appreciation.

Dr. Glenn M. Kidder has served on the visiting faculty at the Pankey Institute in Key Biscayne, Florida for the past 18 years. He has served at the second level course which deals primarily with TMJ dysfunction, occlusal disease, splint therapy, equilibration and esthetics in restorative dentistry.

A 1980 graduate of LSU School of Dentistry, he is in private practice in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. His practice is limited to the treatment of temporomandibular joint and occlusal disorders. He is a Diplomate with The American Board of Orofacial Pain, a Fellow in The International College of Dentistry, a Fellow in The Academy of General Dentistry, A Fellow in The Pierre Fauchard Academy, a Fellow in The American Academy of Orofacial Pain, and a 28 year member of the American Equilibration Society.

He is past president of the Greater Baton Rouge Dental Association, and was instrumental in the start up of the Greater Baton Rouge Community Clinic which has provided over \$3.5 million of free medical and dental care to the working uninsured.
