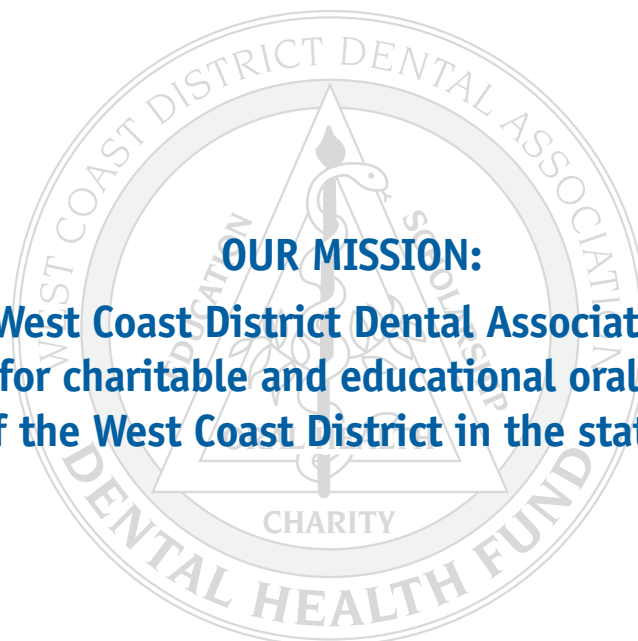
How can you get involved?
